Tips for a Successful Consignment


- Encourage your friends, family, and other contacts to purchase your book at BookPeople.
- Contact your local media and mailing lists to let them know that your book is available at BookPeople.
- Send out press releases, review copies, and other promotional materials.
- Get involved with book clubs, libraries, and other community organizations. Greater success comes from a wide array of authorcoordinated promotion.





Why Consignment?

Consigning books allows BookPeople to carry and feature a much wider variety of self-published and print-on-demand titles than we could through traditional purchasing. We are able to devote more time and expertise to these titles and assist authors in selling more books.

General Policy Information

- The basic handling fee for consignment books is \$25.
- BookPeople will pay up to 55% for a consignment.
- In keeping with the appearance of our general inventory, only bound books with legible titles on their spines will be considered.
- BookPeople will initially take 6 copies of the book.
- BookPeople agrees to display books left here on consignment for 3 months.
- During the initial 3-month period, BookPeople may contact the consignor to request additional copies of the book, and/or to pay the consignor for items already sold.
- At the end of the consignment agreement, BookPeople will return any unsold books and any payment accrued from book sales to the consignor.
- BookPeople will dispose of books left for more than 6 months without a valid return address.
- BookPeople will only pay for items that were sold. Damaged or stolen items are the sole financial responsibility of the consignor.

Additional Promotional Packages

For \$75 we will:

• Feature your book for at least two weeks on our Whale display (see picture) at the front of the store.

Please note that it takes 3-4 weeks from the start of the consignment agreement to be placed on the Whale.

For \$125 we will:

- Feature your book for at least two weeks on the Whale display at the front of the store.
- Feature your book in our e-mail newsletter.
- Enable customers to buy your book on our website for the entire duration of the consignment agreement.

Please note that it takes 4-6 weeks to be featured in the e-mail newsletter and for your title to appear for sale on our website.

For \$225 we will:

• Offer everything in the \$125 package PLUS a book signing event with three other local authors. Please note that the booksigning event will be scheduled to occur 1-4 months after the consignment agreement is placed.

For these packages you must provide:

- 10 copies of your book.
- A short critical review of your book (50 words or fewer).
- · A JPEG image of your book cover for feature on our website.

NOTE ABOUT THE FEES: BookPeople handles hundreds of consignments per year. These fees allow us to continue to accept professionally-produced, self-published books from our local authors. Through this program, consignors now have the same promotional opportunities that traditional publishers enjoy at BookPeople.
